











Materials Needed

- 4 Styrofoam plates
- Black construction paper
- Orange construction paper
- White construction paper
- Red construction paper
- 4 small black beads
- White yarn
- Small bow
- Glue
- Tape
- Scissors







Instructions

- 1. Use scissors to carefully cut out center of each of the Styrofoam plates, one at a time. Save one of the centers of the plates to form the snowman's head. Cut two mediumsized circles out of the black construction paper. Then, cut two small circles out of the white construction paper. Cut a triangular shape out of the orange construction paper to make the nose.
- 2. Glue the black and white circles and orange triangle onto the Styrofoam plate circle you saved to form the snowman's face. Glue the black beads onto the bottom of the face to form the mouth.
- 3. Use the black construction paper to cut a square shape to form the top of the hat, then a longer, thinner strip to form the brim of the hat. Glue the strip to the square shape. Then, cut a small strip of red construction paper the width of the top of the hat to form an embellishment for the hat, and glue straight above the black strip. Glue the bow to either side of the red strip to give your snowman a little flair!
- 4. Lay two of the plates onto a flat surface. Using tape, secure the yarn on the bottom inside of the bottom plate, then, secure the yarn at the top of the next plate, making sure that the yarn is straight, in the center of each plate, and firmly secured onto the plate.
- 5. Take the other plates and spread a small amount of glue around the outside rim, then press to secure on top of the other plates, forming two sides for each part of the snowman's body. Cut three circles out of the black construction paper and tape to the yarn so that they are positioned inside of the snowman's body circles (see photo).
- 6. Use a piece of tape to secure the snowman's head to the top of the remaining yarn. Cut yarn above the head to the desired length.
- 7. You are all done! Enjoy your new snowman buddy!
