PAPER PLATE ANGEL DECORATIONS

Materials Needed:

- Crayons, markers, or colored pencils
- Scissors
- Glue
- Tape
- Yellow pipe cleaner
- Construction paper
- Large thin paper plate with ridges

Instructions:

Color then cut out the patterns on page 17. Take a paper plate and fold it in half.

Next, fold it in half again to form a triangle.

Tape the paper plate sides together to form a cone,

which can stand upright. Cut out 2 triangle shapes from

another paper plate to create angel arms.

Cut out hands from construction paper and glue to the wide end of the arms.

Fold the point of the triangle to create a tab to use to attach the arms.

Wrap the arms around the paper plate and tape the tab to the back of the angel.

Glue the cut-out wing patterns over the arm tabs on the back. Glue on the head.

Take the pipe cleaner and twist to make a circle for the halo with a stem in the back.

Place the halo stem in between the creases of the paper plate on the top to secure the halo.



COFFEE FILTER ANGELS

Materials Needed:

- 3 Coffee filters
- Ribbon
- Large cotton ball or small styrofoam balls
- Glitter
- Scissors
- Glue

Instructions:

Fold coffee filter in half and then in half again to form a triangle for the body.

Fluff the body so it stands like a cone. Wrap a second coffee filter around a large cotton ball or a styrofoam ball to form the head and then secure with ribbon.

Insert the triangular body into the center of the head coffee filter and glue in place.

Take remaining coffee filter and cut in half. Fold each half in half again to form the wings.

Glue one half on each side of the body of your angel.

Decorate your angel using glue and glitter.
